## Rebuilding of Bridgetown Port Main Gate

Barbados Port Inc. wishes to advise the public that the Main Gate to the Bridgetown Port is being rebuilt by ADC Building and Maintenance Ltd. The construction is expected to be completed in 18 weeks.

The fifty-six years old gate had to be replaced in the interest of safety and operational advancement. The old gate accommodated one main road for entry, one for exit and an emergency exit road. The new gate will retain these roads and be enhanced with two new roads dedicated to pedestrians and taxis. It will also feature two levels and will be covered by a canopy that offers protection from the elements.

During the construction, the public must enter and exit the port from the Cargo Gate on Harbour Road. This is the gate located on the road leading to BICO Limited along Sugar Store Road.

Taxi operators exclusively will continue to be allowed entry into the port from the area of the Main Gate in a specially designated lane located at the edge of the Trevor's Way Roundabout. All traffic, however, including taxis must exit via the Cargo Gate. It is anticipated that there may be intermittent delays at the gate due to the high volume of traffic expected as passengers, visitors and cargo will now be using the same gate.

Further, all traffic exiting the Port from the Cargo Gate must turn left at the end of Sugar Store Road onto Prescod Boulevard. The details of these traffic changes can be obtained from the Port's website - [www.barbadosport.com](http://www.barbadosport.com).
