Barbados Port Inc. invites tenders from qualified suppliers for the supply of the following various oils and lubricants for the duration of one (1) year:

Description	General Requirements
Gear Oils	High performance gear oils in premium quality with API specification GL4/ GL5. These should be suitable to lubricate heavy industrial gears and have high load carrying capacity and anti-friction properties.
Hydraulic Oils	Premium quality hydraulic oils should be of high viscosity index, suitable for industrial hydraulic systems, hydraulic fluid power transmission systems and marine hydraulic systems.
Transmission Oils	High quality automatic transmission fluids which provide outstanding oxidation resistance, high anti-wear, anti-rust and corrosion protection for gears, pumps and other drive train components.
Engine Oils	High performance oils suitable for use in a broad range of on and off-road turbo engines.

Detailed technical specifications of the oils and lubricants required are contained in tender documents, which will be delivered via email on confirmation of electronic payment of Bds\$50.00.

Tenderers must submit the following in their bids:

- a. Copies of the company's Certificate and Articles of Incorporation, Certificate of Incumbency and Certificate of Good Standing.

Tenders are to be submitted to the Barbados Port Inc. Tenders and Procurement Committee by hand in a sealed envelope which must bear the words "Supply of Oils and Lubricants" and shall be addressed to:

Additional Instructions:

All tenders must include in their bids the following supporting documentation:

1. MSDS Sheets for all oils and lubricants being proposed.
2. A technical data sheet for each oil and lubricant
3. Evidence to show capability to deliver the products to Barbados Port Inc. at the supplier's expense as scheduled.
4. Evidence to support having executed the supply of at least one order per year for the supply of oils and lubricants to Government/ Semi-Government or reputed private companies during the past two to three years from the date of the submission of the tender.
5. The supplier should indicate spare capacity for meeting the Port's tender quantity, for which the offer is being submitted.

Costing should include VAT along with supply and delivery to the Port on a weekly or as needed basis.
