

## TENDER NOTICE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THREE (3) SUGAR LOADERS & ASSOCIATED CONVEYOR SYSTEM

Sealed tenders are invited from qualified service providers to dismantle, remove and dispose of three Sugar Loaders and the Associated Conveyor System located in the Port of Bridgetown.

Service providers are expected to inspect and conduct sample tests on all structures scheduled for removal to determine if asbestos is present. In the event that asbestos is confirmed, the removal and disposal must be in compliance with all regulations, laws, rules and procedures as outlined by the **Environment Protection Department** pertaining to asbestos.

Detailed technical specifications of the service required are contained in tender documents, which will be delivered via email on confirmation of electronic payment of Bds\$100.00.

Tenderers must submit the following in their bids:

- a. Copies of the company's Certificate and Articles of Incorporation, Certificate of Incumbency and Certificate of Good Standing.
- b. Operation methodology describing how the service will be executed.
- c. Details of on-site safety, environmental procedures, waste disposal and concrete works must be included.

Costing must be VAT inclusive.
