INVITATION TO TENDER

REFURBISHMENT OF A 150MM DIAMETER WATER PIPELINE AT THE PORT OF BRIDGETOWN

- 1 The existing water pipeline in the service tunnel of the breakwater arm at the Port of Bridgetown from the Cross Berth to the north has reached the end of its useful life and is in dire need of refurbishment. The current cast iron pipeline is in varied stages of decay. The supporting brackets also show signs of degradation and require replacement.
To enhance the supply of water to visiting vessels, Barbados Port Inc. desires to replace the water pipeline; replace the branches to the water service points; include new disinfection points; and replace all associated valves, hydrants and appurtenances.
- 2 Barbados Port Inc. is inviting suitably qualified contractors with proven experience in pipeline construction and maintenance to submit tenders for the refurbishment of a 150mm diameter water pipeline in the Port of Bridgetown.

- 4 All Tenders must be submitted electronically via the Government of Barbados's e-Procurement portal. Vendors must first register on the portal in order to submit their proposals. Detailed instructions for registration are available at <https://procure.gov.bb/home>
- 5 Any queries concerning the details provided in the tender documents should be submitted through the portal's messaging feature.

- 6 Tenderers should be aware that the Labour Clause (Public Contracts) Act, CAP 349 shall in so far as is applicable to the Tender, apply to any contract made in respect of the Tender. Full details of the conditions of the Act, CAP 349 may be obtained from the Government Printing Department, Bay Street, St. Michael.
- 7 Tenderers should be aware of Safety and Health at Work Act CAP 356.
- 8 Tenderers should submit the Certificate required by Paragraph 3 of the Schedule to the Act with their tenders.
- 9 All Corporate Tenderers must upload to their vendor profile or include with their submission a copy of the Company's Certificate of Incorporation/Articles of Incorporation as evidence of the fact that the company is an existing registered company as at the date of the application. The Certificate must be in the name of the firm submitting the proposal. Failure to provide the Certificate of Incorporation/Articles of Incorporation will render the bid void.
- 10 Local Tenderers are advised that the Certificate of Incorporation referred to above means a Certificate of Incorporation issued under the 1985 Companies Act of Barbados or where applicable a certificate of continuance and/or a Certificate of Amalgamation or a Certificate of Amendment.
- 11 Where the supplier of the works is registered under the Business Names Rules you are required to provide a copy of the Business Registration.
- 12 Where the company is registered under the Companies Act of Barbados you are required to provide the following where applicable:
 - i. Barbados Revenue Authority Clearance Certificate
 - ii. NISS Clearance Certificate; and
 - iii. Certificate of Good Standing
- 13 All Tenders must be accompanied by the completed Form of Tender, completed Bill of Quantities and all other required information.
- 14 All proposals should be uploaded to the Government of Barbados' e-procurement portal at <https://govbb.bonfirehub.com/portal/?tab=openOpportunities> no later than **11:30pm AST on Wednesday, March 12, 2025.**
- 15 No Tender will be considered unless it complies with the conditions set out in this Notice

- 16 **A mandatory site visit has been scheduled for February 19, 2025, at 10:00 a.m.;** tenderers are asked to meet at the Southside of the Cruise Terminal.
