



INVITATION TO TENDER

RESURFACING OF THE BLOCK STACK AREA AT PORT OF BRIDGETOWN

- 1 The Block Stack Area at the Port of Bridgetown is used for the storage of empty containers awaiting loading onto vessels. As a key operational area, it supports the efficient movement of cargo and contributes to the effective use of space within the Port. Over time, the asphalt pavement has deteriorated due to heavy vehicular traffic, continuous operational use and normal wear and tear. The deteriorated pavement now requires rehabilitation to maintain a safe and efficient operating environment and to support the continued movement of cargo. Barbados Port Inc. (BPI) therefore intends to resurface the Block Stack Area by removing the existing asphalt pavement, carrying out localized pavement repairs where necessary, and constructing a new asphalt pavement in accordance with the Contract Specifications.
- 2 Barbados Port Inc. is inviting suitably qualified and experienced contractors to tender for the resurfacing of the Block Stack Area located within the Port of Bridgetown.

- 6 All Tenders must be accompanied by the completed Form of Tender, completed Bill of Quantities and all other required information.

- 8 No Tender will be considered unless it complies with the conditions set out in this Notice.
